There are 46 negotiations **currently underway** for the following drug products:

Drug Product Brand Name (Generic Name)	Indication/Use
Afinitor (everolimus)	Used to treat neuroendocrine tumours of gastrointestinal or lung origin
Botox (onabotulinumtoxin A)	Used to treat multiple indications
Brilinta (ticagrelor)	Used with ASA to prevent atherothrombotic events with history of myocardial infarction
Brivlera (brivaracetam)	Used to treat partial-onset seizures
Cinqair (reslizumab)	Used to treat severe eosinophilic asthma
Copaxone (glatiramer acetate)	Used to treat multiple sclerosis
Cosentyx (secukinumab)	Use to treat psoriatic arthritis
Cosentyx (secukinumab)	Used to treat ankylosing spondylitis
Descovy (emtricitabine/tenofovir alafenamide)	Used to treat HIV-1 infection
Fibristal (ulipristal acetate)	Used to treat uterine fibroids (2nd cycle pre-surgery)
Fycompa (perampanel)	Used to treat epilepsy, primary generalized tonic-clonic seizures
Gazyva (obinutuzumab)*	Used to treat follicular lymphoma
Glatect (glatiramer acetate)	Used to treat relapsing-remitting multiple sclerosis
Giotrif (afatinib)	Used to treat advanced non-small cell lung cancer
Hemangirol (propranolol)	Used to treat infantile hemangioma
Ibrance (palbociclib)	Used to treat advanced breast cancer
Invega Trinza (paliperidone palmitate)	Used to treat schizophrenia
Jardiance (empagliflozin)	Used to treat diabetes mellitus (Type 2) for patients with high cardiovascular risk
Keytruda (pembrolizumab)	Used to treat non-small cell lung cancer (second line or beyond)
Keytruda (pembrolizumab)	Used to treat non-small cell lung cancer (first line)
Kuvan (sapropterin dihydrochloride)	Used to treat Phenylketonura (PKU)
Kyleena (levonorgestrel)	Used for the prevention of pregnancy
Kyprolis (carfilzomib)	Used to treat multiple myeloma
Kyprolis (carfilzomib)	Used to treat multiple myeloma (relapsed)
Lynparza (olaparib)*	Used to treat ovarian cancer
Methadose (methadone)	Used to treat opioid dependence
Metoject (methotrexate)	Used to treat rheumatoid arthritis
Mictoryl (propiverine)	Used to treat overactive bladder
Narcan (naloxone hydrochloride)	Used to treat opioid overdose
Nucala (mepolizumab)	Used to treat severe eosinophilic asthma
Odefsey (emtricitabine/rilpivirine/tenofovir alafenamide)	Used to treat HIV-1 infection
Opdivo (nivolumab)	Used to treat squamous cell carcinoma of the head and neck (SCCHN)

<b>Drug Product Brand Name (Generic Name)</b>	<b>Indication/Use</b>
<b>Pheburane (sodium phenylbutyrate)</b>	Used to treat urea cycle disorders
<b>Praluent (alirocumab)</b>	Used for lowering of low density lipoprotein cholesterol (LDL-C) in patients with heterozygous familial hypercholesterolemia (HeFH) or patients at high risk for cardiovascular (CV) events
<b>Quinsair (levofloxacin)</b>	Used to treat cystic fibrosis with chronic Pseudomonas aeruginosa infections
<b>Ravicti (glycerol phenylbutyrate)</b>	Used to treat urea cycle disorders
<b>Revestive (teduglutide)</b>	Used to treat short bowel syndrome (SBS)
<b>Stivarga (regorafenib)</b>	Used to treat metastatic and/or unresectable gastrointestinal stromal tumours (GIST)
<b>Strensiq (asfotase alfa)</b>	Used to treat pediatric-onset hypophosphatasia
<b>Tagrisso (osimertinib)</b>	Used to treat locally advanced or metastatic EGFR T790M mutation-positive non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC) who have progressed on or after EGFR TKI therapy
<b>Taltz (Ixekizumab)</b>	Used to treat moderate to severe plaque psoriasis
<b>Trulicity (dulaglutide)</b>	Used to treat type 2 diabetes mellitus
<b>Uptravi (selexipag)</b>	Used to treat pulmonary arterial hypertension
<b>Vimizim (elosulfase alfa)</b>	Used to treat mucopolysaccharidosis IVA (Morquio A syndrome)
<b>Zykadia (ceritinib)</b>	Used to treat ALK+ non-small cell lung cancer
<b>Xolair (omalizumab)</b>	Used to treat severe persistent asthma
