Dear Prime Minister:

Canada's Premiers met today to discuss challenges and opportunities facing the country. We look forward to a constructive partnership with your government to grow the economy, create jobs and take the necessary steps to address regional disparities across the country.

We invite you to co-host a meeting of First Ministers early in the new year to discuss how to work together to achieve these objectives. To ensure that all priorities are reflected, we suggest that the Prime Minister set the agenda for day one of the meeting, and the Council of the Federation set the agenda for day two on the following topics:

1. Economic Competitiveness;
2. The Fiscal Stabilization Program;
3. Healthcare and Infrastructure; and,
4. Northern Priorities.

Given the significant number of pressing topics to be addressed, we suggest that the discussions remain among First Ministers, and that any guest speakers or presentations be reserved for other occasions.

We have enclosed the communiqué from our meeting.
